

Digital Solution Architect

Job purpose: Providing advice and support (predominantly to the Member Experience (ME) workstream and the TDA), in relation to digital solutions architecture, solution options and selection, agile technology roadmaps, and solution and development overlaps and integrations.

Key Accountabilities:

- Provide target solution architectures across the ME workstream and other workstreams where co-dependent: Road-mapping the appropriate technologies and suppliers for delivering the Member Experience Programme of work, and ensuring streams are aware of the options and decisions they will face. Engagement with IT to ensure technology decisions are consistent with IT architecture principles and the approved target architecture.
- Provide solution choice and discovery advice to stream: Where more than one solution will provide the required functionality for a particular stream and fits the target architecture, advise on the technology options, based on market best-practice as well as functional, non-functional, and wider business requirements and considerations.
- Provide cross-stream awareness of solution overlaps and integration decisions: The Digital Solution Architect will operate across streams, ensuring that, where technologies overlap in their functionality, and where integrations are needed, both the streams and IT are aware and involved in making the right choices for the business and underlying technical architecture as to how technology is deployed and for what functionality.
- Advise on Agile Architecture and Technology choices: Act as advocate for agile architecture and solution decisions. Responsible for advising workstreams and others in IT on applying agile principles to architecture and technology choice.
- Solution integration advice and support: Work with Technical Design Authority, streams, partners and testers, advising on integrations between systems, including how to plan, document and test these effectively.
- Solution Support for the TDA: The role contributes to the TLS Technical Design Authority, providing support with regard to technology assurance, fitness for purpose, and working with InfoSec and Delivery colleagues to give advice on best practice architecture and solutions in their areas of expertise.
- Digital technology futures advice: Keep up to date with market movements, development roadmaps, and major acquisitions and changes in roadmap and strategy of the major players in the digital marketplace and apply this in advising streams on their solution decisions, as well as contributing to the target technical architecture and development roadmap.
- Advise on dependencies and issues in development: Being across all the streams, and understanding the agile development cycle and technology overlaps, the Digital Solution Architect will be responsible for working with the Agile Delivery Manager to advise streams on development overlaps, issues and dependencies – ensuring that IT has a strong and consistent view on Programme planning, and can suitably advise the business based on realistic and achievable roadmaps.
